- Freshen up the apartment with a coat of paint throughout. Alternatively, touch up the paintwork throughout, paying particular attention to any areas where picture frames have been removed and infill holes and repaint.
- Deep clean the property including the windows and balcony or terrace if there is one.
- Shampoo or replace carpets. Local companies can provide
 free quotations to deep clean carpets, or machines can be hired locally.

- Create a clear environment by removing or hiding away the majority of personal items including clothing and toiletries. Ensure cleaning materials in the bathroom and kitchen aren't on show either.
- If you're presenting the property completely unfurnished, don't forget to clear out all goods within the kitchen cupboards and drawers.
- Remove any mobility aids you've had installed.
- If the property has a balcony or terrace, remove pot plants and garden ornaments.

Remember...

Air and clean the property regularly to keep it looking and smelling fresh.



- Remove excess furniture, particularly in the hallway. Too much furniture may create the illusion the apartment is smaller than it is.
- Depersonalise the apartment by removing photographs.
- Beds should be made and ideally presented with duvet, pillows, cushions and throws.
